It was noted that work had been done to fill the potholes on the A484 near the Rock and Fountain.

### **28. Reports from Sub-Committees and Organisations.**

- **Canolfan Cymdeithasol Cynwyl Elfed Hall -** Cllr Elfed Davies represented the Council at an ordinary meeting of the Hall on 11.6.25. He confirmed that the fees for the hire of the hall are to increase. Work to be carried out on the back room of the hall over the next few weeks. The committee has asked for help from anyone who is able to volunteer to carry out repairs and decorating work etc.

Cars continue to park on the right hand side of the hall and it was reported that at times can cause an obstruction.

The hall committee has offered to place any memorial plaques from Capel Bethel on the walls of the hall if the Chapel is sold. It was considered important that these items of historical importance are kept in the village.

**Cae Chwarae Bro Elfed Playing Field -** The Council was informed that there are now only 3 members on the committee. The committee has not been successful in obtaining a grant on this occasion. The original constitution has not been found. A new constitution has been drafted. The Council has committed to paying the insurance costs in respect of the park and has done this for many years. Cllr. Elfed Davies proposed that the Council continues to cover the insurance costs, this was seconded by Cllr. Bryan Davies. In the meantime clerk is to find out whether the insurance in respect of the park can be included under the Council's insurance policy. The Council agreed to pay Land Registry fees in order to make searches of whether the land is registered. Cllr. Amy Evans told the meeting that the park committee is going to arrange a fund raising event during the Summer, possibly a village carnival. Cllr. E. Davies said it was important for parents of young children in the village to get involved and support the park committee.
