

CYNWYL ELFED COMMUNITY COUNCIL COMMUNITY GRANT SCHEME

Cynwyl Elfed Community Council has a Grants Scheme that offers financial support to the community. The grants are allocated in accordance with relevant legislation including the Local Government Act 1972 (sections 137 – 142) and the General Power of Well Being (section 2 of the Local Government Act 2000). The amount of money available is set annually in the budget of the Council.

Priority will be given by the Council to projects and applications that help to achieve the seven well-being goals in the Well-being of Future Generations Act, in other words:

A prosperous Wales

A resilient Wales

A healthier Wales

A more equal Wales

A Wales of cohesive communities

A Wales of vibrant culture and thriving Welsh language

A globally responsible Wales

How to apply –

- An application form should be completed, together with the most recent balance sheet and annual accounts, these should be sent to the Clerk by no later than the closing date stipulated on the application form.
- The Council will normally consider requests once during the year, usually in February, although there may be occasions when the nature of the request may require action to be taken sooner.
- The Council will not normally provide grant support directly to individuals.
- Priority will be given to organisations that directly benefit the areas and individuals who live in areas covered by Cynwyl Elfed Community Council.
